## KNIGHT VISION

41 shooters came out to enjoy October's regularly scheduled monthly match, and JSR's 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Halloween Costume shoot! Thanks to all who showed up and special thanks to our stage writers and steel haulers; we sure do appreciate the help!

Congratulations to October's top three overall shooters, 1<sup>st</sup> **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge, 195.86), 2<sup>nd</sup> **Ramblin Dave** (Senior, 199.69) and 3<sup>rd</sup> **Purgatory Smith** (Gunfighter, 225.32).

*Stage 1* – was written by **The Col.** A chilling Halloween tale of the undead rising and haunting the town of Lithia Springs. The shooter dealt with the “undead” with 12 rounds of shotgun and 10 pistol rounds. Fastest time

on the stage was by **Purgatory Smith**; he shot it in 29.39 seconds.

*Stage 2* – was written by **Jed I. Knight**. This was another dark Halloween tale that required the shooter to fire 10 rounds from their pistols, 9 rounds from their rifle and a minimum of 6 shotgun rounds (all misses could be made up using the shotgun). Fastest time was 33.75 seconds by **Ramblin' Dave**.

*Stage 3* – “Witch's Brew” was written by **Harley Davidson** and the shooter fired off 10 rounds from their pistols, 4 rounds from their shotgun and 10 rounds from their rifle between gathering ingredients for their ghastly concoction. **Ramblin' Dave** had the fastest time at 34.67 seconds.

*Stage 4* – “The Band of Bully's” was written by

young **Emmy Oakley**. The tale had the shooter defending the town of Ashland from the notorious **H. Apple Bob**. The procedure called for 10 rounds from the rifle, 5 rounds from both pistols and a minimum of 6 shotgun rounds while running the length of this wide stage back and forth. Fastest time was by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam**, he shot it in 40.40 seconds.

*Stage 5* – was written by **Kidd Krystin**. This stage was titled “Ghost Riders Near the Ground”. This stage had the shooter meeting the “midnight train to pick up some back ordered Candy Corn”. It required the shooter to defend the train against ghost and werewolves with 10 rifle rounds, 10 pistol rounds and 6 rounds from their shotgun. (Continued on Page 3)
