35 shooters showed up to enjoy the relatively mild weather at JSR's November shoot. Four shooters managed clean matches this month; **Sweetwater Jack** (1st place Classic Cowboy / 18th Overall), **Oxford Kid** (2nd place Modern, 16th Overall), **Half-Fast Rusty** (2nd place Duelist, 5th place Overall) and **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (1st place Frontier Cartridge and 1st place Overall). Congratulations to those "steady handed" shooters. And a big congratulations to our top 3 shooters; 3rd place **Bear Bone Smith** (Traditional with a time of 193.95), **Purgatory Smith** (Gunfighter with a time of 169.67) and 1st Place, **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge with a time of

168.65). Yep, only .82 seconds separated the 1st and 2nd place spots – great show!

Stage 1 – was written by **MT Dawson**. Fastest time on this "shotgun only" stage (written with LOTS of movement) was by **Ramblin' Dave**, he shot it in 45.40 seconds.

Stage 2 – "Thanksgiving with Your Folks" was written by **Harley Davidson**. This stage required the shooter to expend 10 pistol rounds, 10 rifle rounds and 4 shotgun rounds. Fastest time was 23.59 by **Ramblin' Dave**.

Stage 3 – "Thanksgiving with the In-Laws and Out-laws" was written by me. This stage required four rounds of shotgun, nine rounds from the rifle and 10 rounds from the pistols. Fastest time on this stage was by **Purgatory**

Smith, he shot it in 29.23 seconds.

Stage 4 – "Thanksgiving with H. Apple Bob" was written by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam**. On this stage the shooter used 10 pistol rounds, 10 rifle rounds and a minimum of 6 shotgun rounds to dispatch the steel targets. Fastest time was by **Purgatory Smith**, he shot it in 30.57 seconds.

That's all I have for this month. I hope everyone reading this had a wonderful Christmas and a safe and happy New Year. I'll see you on the ranges in January.
