KNIGHT VISION

Only 17 shooters were able to thaw themselves enough to participate in December's monthly match. Only one of those shooters, **Kidd Krystin** (perhaps with the aid of his minions), was able to steady himself from the chilling shakes to shoot a clean match. Top 3 shooters for December were; 1st place, **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge 172.15 seconds) 2nd place, **Purgatory Smith** (Gunfighter 177.23 seconds) and 3rd place, **Bear Bone Smith** (Traditional 219.38 seconds).

Stage 1- was "A Christmas Eve Story" written by **JD Walker**. This stage had the shooter firing a minimum of 16 rounds from the shotgun followed by 10 shots from the pis-

tols. Fastest time on this stage was 41.64 seconds by **Purgatory**.

Stage 2 - "Christmas Delivery" was written by me. This stage required 10 rounds from the pistols, 10 rounds from the rifle and a minimum of 3 rounds from the shotgun (*all misses could be made up with the shotgun*). The fastest time was 25.97 seconds by **Purgatory**.

Stage 3 - "Coal for Christmas" was written by **Sourdough Smitty**. This stage had the shooter using two pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, one rifle loaded with 10 rounds, 1 shotgun with a minimum of 4 rounds. The fastest time on this stage was 37.20 seconds by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam**.

Stage 4 - "The Polar Express" was written by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam**.

This stage required the shooter to use 10 rounds from the rifle, 10 rounds from 2 pistols and a minimum of six shotgun rounds. Fastest time on this stage was 35.02 seconds by **Purgatory**.

Stage 5 - "Bear's Dinner" was written by **Treacherous Jack** and **Derringer Donna**. This stage had the shooter put 10 rounds from the rifle and a minimum of 6 rounds from the shotgun downrange.
