KNIGHT VISION

Howdy all! January's JSR match brought out 22 shooters. Top three shooters for the match were 3rd place, **Just Bill** (49er, total time 205.11), 2nd place, **Treacherous Jack** (Traditional, total time 200.65) and 1st place went to **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge, 161.32).

Stage 1 "Derail the Train", written by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam**, required the shooter use 2 pistols with 5 rounds each and a shotgun with a minimum of 10 rounds to try and stop *Jed I. Knight* from escaping with on the train with a load of stolen gold. Fastest time on the stage was by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge)

he shot it in 34.30 seconds.

Stage 2 "Shootin' Stars" was written by **Jed I. Knight**. In this scenario the shooter, a working cowhand, had to protect the property of the Cattle Queen, *Shootin' Silver Star*. Rustler's were discovered thieving her cattle and the shooter had to dispatch them using 1 rifle (loaded with 10 rounds), 2 pistols (loaded with 5 rounds each) and a shotgun (minimum of 4 rounds needed to get the job done). Fastest time on this stage was **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge) he shot it in 29.68 seconds!

Stage 3, this month's winner of the coveted Shooter's Choice Award for Best Stage, was written by **Just Bill**. This stage had the shooter

sitting around a real campfire (those that were there can attest to just how nice it was to thaw in front of the fire!) hunting game. Nine rifle rounds, 10 pistol rounds and 6 shotgun rounds were expended from a comfortable seated position (even wrapped in a blanket) in front of the fire. Fastest time on this stage was by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge), he must have been warm enough because he chose to leave the comfort of the fire in just 31.24 seconds.

Stage 4, "A Baaaaad Night" was written by **Sourdough Smitty**. This scenario had the shooter playing cards with the infamous *J.D. Walker*. When the card cheating and sheepherding stories got too much for the

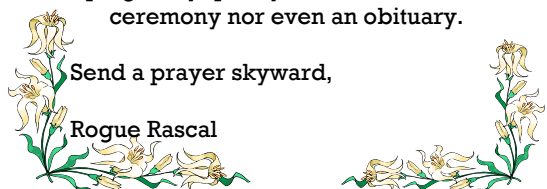

Stage 5 was a re-shoot of Stage 4 (we were sharing our range this month with the National Guard) – with everything being the same... except the outcome, this time around the fastest time was turned in by Treacherous Jack (Traditional), he shot it in 33.57 seconds.
