## KNIGHT VISION

Howdy all! 51 Shooters came out to celebrate St. Patrick's Day with a BOOM!

The top three shooters for March's match were; 3<sup>rd</sup> place, **Ramblin' Dave** (Senior, total time 196.58), 2<sup>nd</sup> place, **Purgatory Smith** (Gunfighter, total time 182.52) and 1<sup>st</sup> place went to **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge, total time 171.60). There were also 3 clean matches; **Guano** (B-Western, total time 242.77), **Oxford Kid** (Modern, total time 294.76) and **Fairweather Kate** (Ladies Senior, total time 349.45). Congratulations to all of our quick and accurate shooters; you inspire us all!

As always, special thanks to

all of our stage writers and to those that show up early to help set up steel.

Stage 1, "Stoppin' Sourdough Smitty", was written by **Jed I. Knight**. This stage, the JSR "shotgun stage" required a minimum of 11 shotgun rounds and 10 rounds out 2 pistols. The fastest time on the stage was by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge and hammered double-barrel shooter), The Col. shot the stage in 39.09 seconds.

Stage 2 "Leprechaun's on the Run" was penned by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam**. The story told of a gang of Young Guns (*Lithia Star*, *Kook*, *Gunslinger Cody* and *The Crossfire Kid*) stopping the robbery of a train by a gang of Leprechauns (*The*

*Outrider*). The stage required 2 pistols loaded with five rounds each, a shotgun with 4 rounds and a rifle loaded with 10 rounds. The fastest time on this stage was **Rocky Hill Rustler** (Duelist) he shot it in 33.77 seconds!

Stage 3, "Just Quit Moving", was written by **Just Bill**. This stage made use of a new moving target designed by Just Bill. The target and shooting sequence required a keen eye, sharp mind and a quick gun hand. The shooter needed 10 pistol rounds, 10 rifle rounds and a minimum of 4 shotgun rounds. Fastest time was 34.88 seconds by **Purgatory Smith** (Gunfighter). (Continued on Page 4)

The shooter needed 2 pistols loaded with 5 rounds each, a rifle loaded with 9 rounds and a shotgun with a minimum of 4 rounds. The fastest time on this stage was **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge) with a time of 28.97 seconds!

Stage 5, "Leprechaun's Revenge", was written by **Harley Davidson**. In this scenario the shooter, being too scared to rob a stage coach and too lazy

for a real job, decides to steal some Leprechaun gold! Unfortunately this Leprechaun had lots of friends! Battling the Leprechaun and his friends required two pistols loaded with 5-rounds each, 1 rifle loaded with 10 rounds (and two extra rounds reloaded on the clock by the shooter!) and 4 rounds for the shotgun. Fastest stage time was by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge) he shot it in 28.89 seconds.
