Howdy all! 35 Shooters came out to April's JSR Monthly match, including a Buckaroo (**Kid Gun**slinger), a Buckarette (**Kookanadude**) and a Young Gun (**Crossfire Kid**)!

The top three shooters for March's match were; 3rd place, Purgatory Smith (Gunfighter, total time 174.67), 2nd place, Ramblin' Dave (Senior, total time 163.68) and 1st place went to Col. Cornelius Gilliam (Frontier Cartridge, total time 158.91). There were also 4 clean Chuck matches; Up (Traditional), Just Bill (49'r), Bloody Bill Anderson (Elder Statesman) and Col. Cornelius Gilliam (Frontier Cartridge).

Of course, as always, a *special thanks* to all of our stage writers and to those that show up early to help set up steel and stay after to help us tear down steel.

Stage 1, "Peppered with Buckshot", was written by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam**. This stage required a minimum of 10 shotgun rounds and 10 rounds out of 2 pistols. The fastest time on the stage was by **Ramblin' Dave** (Senior), he shot the stage in 27.73 seconds.

Stage 2 "Going in Circles" was penned by **JD**

Walker. The stage required 2 pistols loaded with five rounds each, a shotgun with 6 rounds (minimum) and a rifle loaded with 10 rounds. The fastest time on this stage was **Ramblin'** Dave (Senior) he shot it in 28.91 seconds!

Stage 3, "Just Quit Moving", was written by **Just Bill**. The shooter needed 10 pistol rounds, 10 rifle rounds and a minimum of 4 shotgun rounds. Fastest time was 26.61 seconds by **Col. Cornelius Gilliam** (Frontier Cartridge).

Stage 4, "Circled Wagons" was written by **Jed I. Knight**. This stage required 10 rounds in the (*Continued on Page 3*)


