SPOTTERS:

Remember, if you think it is a hit, it's a HIT. If you think it is a miss, it is a HIT! You actually have to SEE THE MISS. Don't listen for the sound of ringing steel (some targets are "dead"); don't look to the other spotters to see what they came up with. Pay careful attention when counting - and if you are distracted by something tell the Timer Operator that when asked for your count.
